

Essential Photo Shoot Instructions

Before the Shoot:

1. If you choose to cut or color your hair make sure to do it at least a week in advance. You cannot cancel your shoot the day before because you got a bad haircut!
2. Ladies should avoid eyelash extensions. Agents and Managers rarely accept headshots with them on. If you insist, you can wear them but there will be no reshooting if they are not acceptable.
3. Go over the clothing ideas in this packet and make sure you have everything you need. Always err on the side of bringing too much!
4. Make sure all of the clothing you bring is clean and pressed.
5. Do not Tan or Spray Tan before your shoot.
6. About one week prior to the shoot you will receive a reminder email with the exact location along with directions and parking information.

Day of the Shoot:

1. Allow plenty of time to get to Seattle and park.
2. Arrive 15 minutes (max) before your shoot.
3. Please refrain from bringing more than one guest with you. Space is limited.
4. You must arrive with clean, dry hair. Stylist will not work on wet or greasy hair.
5. Your first look in any shoot will be your headshot. It is crucial that your headshot looks like you and how you will present in in-person or on-line castings.
6. For this reason, please come with your hair styled the way you like it best. If you wear make-up, please come with that applied as well. The more natural the better.
7. Do not bring or wear any jewelry.
8. If you wear nail polish please make sure it is a neutral color.
9. After any touch up or outfit change, you MUST look in the mirror and sign off that you are happy with the look prior to shooting.

After the Shoot:

1. Your photos will be emailed to you in 10-14 days.
2. Email will come from photos@seattletalent.net. Add that to your address book and watch for the email.
3. If you do not receive them within 14 days, please email photos@seattletalent.net.
4. You will receive a Dropbox link to download all your photos.
5. Inside the folder you download will be a second folder containing the ones we selected and touched up for you.
6. You will also receive a separate link to our photo resource site which will have information on how to print your photos (if necessary) and also how to submit them to the Seattle Artists Agency website to create your online profile with the agency.

Clothing Suggestions

The key is to look at all of the options in your cast type and find the images you feel you can represent best. Then find clothing to copy those looks. If you are in between two divisions, feel free to look at both that may apply. Our goal is to keep you looking stylish AND age appropriate.

Photo Shoot Packages

Two Look Headshot Package - \$325

- Your headshot is used to promote you to agents, managers, and casting directors. They are choosing to promote you - AS YOU MOST COMMONLY LOOK. You must present them with a headshot that represents how you appear when self-taping for casting opportunities. Having your headshot look as you present yourself is ESSENTIAL. Headshots with a smile are most common.
- Bring 5-6 options of shirts and two options for pants.
- All clothing should be cleaned and pressed.
- Stay away from solid white, stripes, or anything with large logos.
- Refer to the clothing links above and copy the ideas for the looks that are “you”.
- Some clients have many headshots that represent them in several categories. The more options you give your agent the more successful you will be.

Four Look Full Shoot - \$550

- This shoot will contain a variety of looks based on your areas of interest and potential.
- For Actors this can be four different headshot looks.
- For Models this can be four different modeling looks.
- If you are interested in both acting and modeling it will be a combination of both.
- Bring a lot of options for this shoot including shoes. We will select four different outfits so the more options the better.
- Stay away from anything too dressy. Casual and fun always works best.
- Refer to the clothing links above and copy ideas for the looks that are “you”.
- All clothing should be cleaned and pressed.
